YBOA NATIONAL ACHIEVEMENT AWARDS DESCRIPTIONS

The following awards will be presented at the 2010 YBOA National Championship Tournament. These awards will be presented to members of the YBOA family who are in attendance at the National Tournament. The awards will be presented at the National Skills Contest Finals on Tuesday night. Please take a moment to read a brief description and requirements of each award.

2010 YBOA LEADERSHIP AWARD

If you have someone in your organization that you feel should receive recognition for their hard work and outstanding leadership, nominate them for this award. We will have a committee that will select a person from each age group. This person should be an adult affiliated with the team (i.e., coach, parent), not an actual player. Nominee must have been apart of YBOA organization for a minimum of 5 years.

2010 YBOA STUDENT-ATHLETE ACADEMIC AWARD

YBOA will comprise an All-Tournament Academic Team with five players from each age division. If you wish to have a member of your team considered, please fill out the Academic All-Tournament Player form completely and return to YBOA. Player must have a minimum GPA of 3.5 (cumulative) to be considered for this award. Limit one nomination per team.

2010 YBOA TEAM ACADEMIC AWARD

If you would like to have your team recognized as a top Academic All-Tournament Team at YBOA Nationals, please complete the Academic All-Tournament Team form and follow all the requirements. There will be one team selected in each age group for this award. Team must have a minimum GPA of 3.0 (cumulative) to be considered for this award.

2010 YBOA HUMANITARIAN AWARD

This award will be presented to the person who most exemplifies a true Humanitarian. One who shows concern for others at all times and contributes their time and efforts within their community to help those who need assistance. If there is someone within your organization who demonstrates these values, please complete the Humanitarian Award form completely and return to YBOA. Limit one nomination per team.

2010 YBOA "ULTIMATE TEAM MOM" AWARD

This award will be presented to the person who most exemplifies a true "caretaker" of a team or organization. This person who normally goes unrecognized yet works tirelessly at organizing and caring for the needs and concerns of players, coaches, and parents of a YBOA team. If there is someone on your team or within your organization who demonstrates these values, please complete the "Ultimate Team Mom" Award form completely and return to YBOA. Limit one nomination per team.
