YBOA Membership Benefits

ASSOCIATION MEMBERSHIP

Your team or club must be a member of YBOA in order to participate in YBOA programs or events. YBOA offers 3 levels of Association Membership.

1-team Association Membership
\$35.00 per year (September 1 – August 31)

2-team Association Membership *
\$70.00 per year (September 1 – August 31)

Multi-team Association Membership *
\$100.00 per year (September 1 – August 31)

*Only teams with identical names within any multi-team association are allowed to move players up or down an age group without a player release form. All other teams within this association must follow the player transfer guidelines as outlined in YBOA rules 3.9 and 3.10.

All YBOA programs are in effect from September 1, 2009 or when payment is received through August 31, 2010, unless otherwise noted.

INDIVIDUAL PLAYER INSURANCE

This plan is available to teams or leagues that have year-round or long-term programs and is mandatory for those teams who wish to participate in YBOA-Sanctioned events. The cost is \$13 per player, which includes secondary accident and liability coverage. A Player Registration Form (Roster) must be completed and verified by the YBOA National Office in order for this program to be in effect.

LEAGUE/RECREATIONAL PROGRAM

Teams or leagues that run short-term programs or choose not to participate in any YBOA-Sanctioned events can benefit from this program. The cost is \$6.00 per player and is valid for a maximum of 6 months. (Unfortunately, there is no pro-rating or cost reduction if you later decide to purchase Individual Player Insurance.)

ADDITIONAL INSURED CERTIFICATES

Additional insured certificates are available for all teams or leagues that are current Association Members and have registered ALL of their participants through one of the YBOA player programs. There is a \$25 fee per certificate.

CAMP INSURANCE

YBOA offers camp insurance to our Association Members. Our rates are very competitive and camp staff coverage is included at no additional charge. Great for large and small camps!

COACHES & OFFICIALS ASSOCIATION

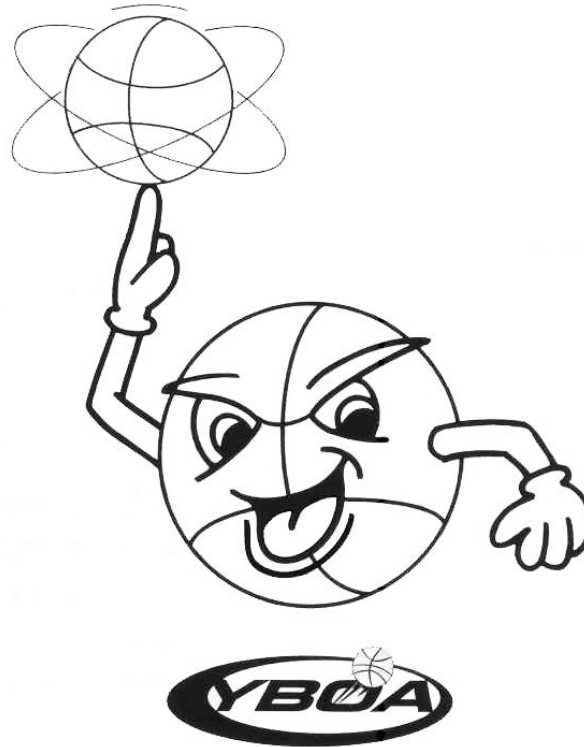

Who is YBOA?

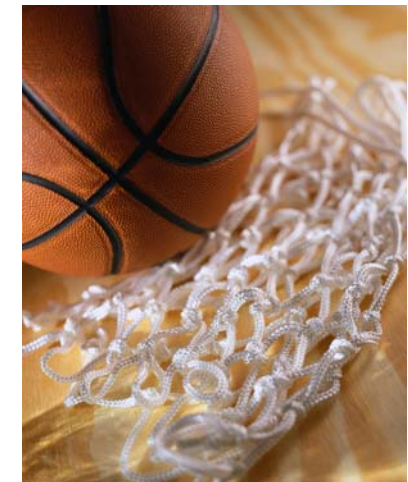
